Reading Between The Lines // Week 2

Jesus spoke all these things to the crowd in parables; he did not say anything to them without using a parable. So was fulfilled what was spoken through the prophet: "I will open my mouth in parables, I will utter things hidden since the creation of the world."

Matthew 13:34-35

"The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed, which a man took and planted in his field. Though it is the smallest of all seeds, yet when it grows, it is the largest of garden plants and becomes a tree, so that the birds come and perch in its branches." **Matthew 13:31-32**

"Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you."

Matthew 17:20-21

Faith is TRUSTING God enough to do what he says.

3 steps to grow faith like a mustard seed:

1. Use what you have been GIVEN.

"Walk out in front of the people. Take your staff. Strike the rock, and water will come gushing out." So Moses struck the rock as he was told, and water gushed out. **Exodus 17:5-6**

2. Be FAITHFUL right where you are.

"May you never bear fruit again!" And immediately the fig tree withered up. "I tell you the truth, if you have faith, you can do things like this and much more. You can even say to this mountain, 'May you be lifted up and thrown into the sea,' and it will happen."

Matthew 21:19, 21

3. Get STARTED today!

Do not despise these small beginnings, for the Lord rejoices to see the work begin. **Zechariah 4:10**
