Kingdom Come // Week 3

Three main points of Jesus' message:

*"The time has come," he said. "The **Kingdom** of God has come near." **Mark 1:15***

1. The time has come for a new REIGN in the world.

*"Repent and believe the good news!" **Mark 1:15***

2. Repent and CHANGE your mind.

*"That is why I tell you not to worry about everyday life - whether you have enough food and drink, or enough clothes to wear. Isn't life more than food, and your body more than clothing?" **Matthew 6:25***

*"So don't worry about these things, saying, 'What will we eat? What will we drink? What will we wear?' For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. **Matthew 6:31-32***

*"Seek first his **Kingdom** and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well." **Matthew 6:33***

3. Seek first what the Kingdom VALUES.

Kingdom Values:

1. SERVE.

2. SACRIFICE.

3. PUT OTHERS FIRST.

*Our Father in heaven, may your name be kept holy. May your **Kingdom** come soon. May your **will** be done on earth, as it is in heaven. **Matthew 6:9-10***

These questions are designed to help groups discuss the weekend teaching while building relationships with each other and growing in our faith!

WARM UP

1. Have you ever been identified by something you DO rather than who you ARE? What happened?

2. When you think of the word "KING", what images or feelings come to mind?

3. Be honest - do you tend to see Jesus more as a *Savior* or as a *King*? Why do you think that is?

KNOW IT

1. Read **Matthew 6:33**. What does it practically mean to "seek first" God's Kingdom? What do you think Jesus means by "all these things"?

2. Read **Matthew 6:9-10**. How does this prayer connect our daily choices with the coming of God's Kingdom? What would that look like in real life?

3. Read **Genesis 3:1-6**. How do these verses reveal our human tendency to trust ourselves more than God? How do you see that same struggle play out in your own life or in culture today?

4. Read **Colossians 1:13-14**. According to these verses, Jesus didn't just *forgive* us - he *transferred* us into a new Kingdom. How does this expand our view of Jesus from *Savior* to being our *King*?

SHARE IT

1. "Many who call themselves Christians swear allegiance to a King they live in defiance of." Why do you think that is such a common experience? What would it look like to live under the authority of King Jesus in your everyday world?

2. Moment of honesty: Where do you *personally* struggle most to surrender and trust Jesus' rule and leadership in your life? Time, money, relationships, decisions?

3. What are you afraid to give up to make that happen? What do you think your life might look like a year from now if you do? What might it look like if you don't?

LIVE IT

1. Jesus said to "repent", which means to *change your mind*. What's one mindset or belief that you need to change in order to align more fully with God's Kingdom?

2. Choose one **Kingdom Value** to focus on this week:

- Serving someone in a practical way.
- Sacrificing something for the good of another.
- Putting someone else's needs ahead of your own.

What's a specific step you can take in that direction?

3. End by praying together the Lord's Prayer - intentionally thinking about how you can live out "Your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven."
