Kingdom Come // Week 5

Before me every knee will bow; by me every tongue will swear." Isaiah 45:23

"Here is my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen one in whom I delight; I will put my Spirit on him, and he will bring justice to the nations." **Isaiah 42:1**

He will not falter or lose heart until justice prevails throughout the earth. And his name will be the hope of all the world." This is what the Lord God says... "I will keep you and will make you to e a covenant for the people and a light for the Gentiles..." Isaiah 41:4-6

He unrolled the scroll and found the place where this was written: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, for he has **anointed me** to bring Good News... to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor." Then he rolled up the scroll, gave it back to the attendant and sat down. the eyes of everyone in the synagogue were fastened on him. He began by saying to them, "Today this scripture is fulfilled in your hearing." **Luke 4:17-21**

WARM UP

1. When you look back over your life, what's one area where you can clearly see God's faithfulness at work?



KNOW IT

- 1. Read **Luke 4:17-21**. How do you think the people in the synagogue felt when Jesus said, "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing"? What does this moment reveal about Jesus' understanding of his mission?
- 2. Read **Matthew 28:19-20**. What does it mean that *all authority* has been given to Jesus? How does this passage describe our role as Kingdom participants?
- 2. How has this series impacted you personally? What has been your biggest takeaway?
- 3. Read **Colossians 1:13-14**. What kind of "kingdom transfer" does this verse describe? how is this Kingdom different from what we often think of when we hear the word "kingdom"?
- 4. Read **Revelation 11:15**. How does this verse tie the whole *story arc* of Scripture together? What hope does this promise give us when it feels like darkness is winning?



SHARE IT

- 1. This week's teaching emphasized that "The Kingdom of God grows one heart and one mind at a time." How have you see this truth play out in your own life or someone else's?
- 2. Jesus' Kingdom advances not by force or power, but through transformed hearts. What makes this approach so different from how "kingdoms of men" usually operate?
- 3. When you think about our church community, where do you see the "yeast" of God's Kingdom at work right now?



LIVE IT

- 1. The Kingdom of God grows like a mustard seed small but unstoppable. What's one small, faithful step you can take this week that could make a big Kingdom impact over time?
- 2. "The Kingdom of God grows one heart and mind at a time." Who's one person you can intentionally pray for / invest in this week so they might see God's love through you?
- 3. Is there ONE area of your life you haven't fully surrendered to *King Jesus*? What might it look like to take a step of obedience in that area?
