

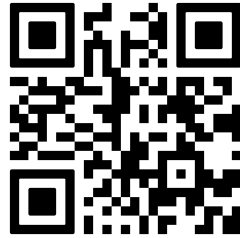
UPCOMING EVENTS:

Reading Between The Lines // Week 5

Now the tax collectors and sinners were all gathering around to hear Jesus. But the Pharisees and the teachers of the law muttered, "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them." Then Jesus told them this parable: "Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Doesn't he leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders and goes home. Then he calls his friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.' I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent. **Luke 15:1-7**

WARM UP

1. Have you ever lost something valuable? What was it and how far were you willing to go to find it?

2. When you hear the word “evangelism”, what thoughts come to your mind? How did this message help change that?

KNOW IT

1. Read **Luke 15:1-7**. Why do you think Luke intentionally mentions both “sinners” and “Pharisees”?

2. What does the shepherd’s response teach us about God’s character?

3. Tony said, “We count who’s here, but God counts who’s missing.” What do you think he meant by that? Why is that important to remember?

4. Read **John 10:11-15**. In these verses, Jesus describes himself as the Good Shepherd. In light of this message, why do you think Jesus uses that metaphor to describe himself?

5. Why is the resurrection of Jesus so central to the Christian faith? How does it shape the way we understand Jesus and his message?

SHARE IT

1. Have you ever viewed God primarily as disappointed or angry with you? What shaped that view?

2. Tony challenged the idea that many people think they have to earn God’s approval. Have you ever struggled with believing you had to “be good enough” for God?

3. Can you remember a time when you personally felt like the “one sheep” God came looking for? Who was someone God used to pursue you or point you to Jesus?

4. Is there someone in your life today who feels far from God? Without sharing anything confidential, how could you be part of the “search party”?

LIVE IT

1. This week, ask God to help you see people the way He does - not just who’s present, but who’s missing. What might change in your daily interactions if you lived with that perspective?

2. Identify one person God has placed in your life who many need some HOPE. What is one simple, authentic step you could take this week to deepen that relationship?

3. Evangelism = “delivering Good News”. How could you naturally share the hope you’ve found in Jesus without feeling pressured to have all the answers?
