Can't Stop Won't Stop // Week 3

The key to money is always MANAGEMENT.

*Don't store up treasures here on earth, where moths and rust destroy them, and where thieves break in and steal. Store your treasures in heaven, where moths and rust cannot destroy, and thieves do not break in and steal. Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be. **Matthew 6:19-21***

4 questions to overcome generosity barriers:

1. Have I settled the issue of OWNERSHIP?
(Deuteronomy 8:17-18)
2. Have I confronted my FEARS?
(Matthew 6:31-33)
3. Am I practicing CONTENTMENT?
(1 Timothy 6:6-8)
4. Do I have an intentional PLAN?
(2 Corinthians 8:7)

God's plan for managing HIS money:

GIVE / SAVE / LIVE

*Make an offering of ten percent, a tithe... bring this into the presence of God... in this way you will learn to live in deep reverence before God as long as you live. **Deuteronomy 14:23***

2 reasons for money:

1. Money is a TRUST.

*Teach those who are rich in this world not to be proud and not to trust in their money, which is so unreliable. Their trust should be in God, who richly gives us all we need for our enjoyment. **1 Timothy 6:17***

2. Money is a TOOL.

*Tell them to use their money to do good. They should be rich in good works and generous to those in need, always being ready to share with others. By doing this they will be storing up their treasure as a good foundation for the future so that they may experience true life. **1 Timothy 6:18-19***

WARM UP

1. What is one thing you once thought you “needed”, only to realize later that you could have lived without it?

2. Who is one of the most generous people you know? What makes their generosity memorable?

KNOW IT

1. Read **Matthew 6:19-21**. What contrast does Jesus make between earthly treasure and heavenly treasure? How does the way we use our money shape what we value?

2. Read **Luke 12:15-21**. Why does Jesus call the wealthy landowner foolish? What is Jesus trying to teach all of us with this story?

3. Read **1 Timothy 6:6-10**. What warnings does Paul give about wealth the desire to become wealthy? According to these verses, what does “true wealth” look like?

4. Read **1 Timothy 6:17-19**. What is the difference between trusting in money and treating money as a tool entrusted by God?

SHARE IT

1. “*Everything I own is on loan.*” What would change if you genuinely viewed everything you have as belonging to God?

2. Which “what if” fear most often makes it difficult for you to live generously?

3. Where are you most tempted to compare with others or believe you need more?

4. Without sharing financial details, would you describe your generosity as “intentional and consistent” or mostly “spontaneous and sporadic”? What has shaped that pattern?

1. Of the four barriers discussed - **ownership, fear, contentment, or planning** - which one is God inviting you to address?

2. Review the two approaches discussed LIVE-SAVE-GIVE vs. GIVE-SAVE-LIVE. What would it take to make generosity a priority rather than an afterthought?

3. Identify one concrete step you can take this week: How can your group help you in that area?
