## **SERMON QUOTES SUNDAY AUGUST 19, 2018**

"Life-giving spiritual fulfillment isn't that complicated. It depends on our relationship to Jesus and the impact and influence of our relationship with Jesus over all of life. The key to godly growth and spiritual maturity is that we can never focus too much on the worthiness and "better-ness" of Jesus."

"You cannot grow into the person God designed for you to be unless you really see Jesus for who He is, and you really trust Him with your entire life (dreams, relationships, defines success, disappointment, etc.)"

"God in all his fullness has chosen to dwell in Christ. This means the attributes and activity of God are revealed in and through Jesus' words, attitudes, actions, and character."
