- 1. Other than Jesus, there are 2 characters in this story... the Pharisee and the woman. The woman is incredibly generous and seizes the opportunity to honor Christ. The Pharisee invited Jesus in and then didn't even give Jesus the greeting of a common Jew more or less a king. In the context of generosity and giving, which of these two characters do you resemble more? Are there changes this motivates you to make?
- 2. Between the Pharisee and the woman, one was available to be used by God and one was not. How available are you to be used by God? Why or why not?
- 3. When the woman approached Jesus, she let down her hair to wipe her tears from Jesus' feet. Letting down her hair was an act of surrender and vulnerability. How willing are you to be vulnerable and just lay it all before Christ? If you do, what do you think God will do in you and others?
