The Proud Chaldean

1. Has to have a crutch

Proverbs 20:1 "Wine is a mocker, strong drink a brawler, and whoever is intoxicated by it is not wise.

Daniel 5:1 "Belshazzar the king held a great feast for a thousand of his nobles, and he was drinking wine in the presence of the thousand.

Daniel 5

25. Now this is the inscription that was written out: 'MENE, MENE, TEKEL, UPHARSIN.'

26. This is the interpretation of the message: 'Mene' - God has numbered your kingdom and put an end to it.

27. 'TEKEL' - you have been weighed on the scales and found deficient.

28. 'PERES' - your kingdom has been divided and given over to the Medes and Persians.

Ephesians 5:18 "And do not get drunk with wine, for that is dissipation, but be filled with the Spirit.

2. Has to dominate others

2 Kings 14:10

You have indeed defeated Edom, and your heart has become proud. Enjoy your glory and stay at home; for why should you provoke trouble so that you, even you, would fall, and Judah with you?"

3. Uses others for their own selfish gain

Psalm 55:22 "Cast your burden upon the Lord and He will sustain you; He will never allow the righteous to be shaken."
