

1. The Father is glorified through the life of His Son. (vv.1-5)

A. Jesus lived in submission to the Father's will (v.2)

John 8:28

Jesus said, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am He, and I do nothing on My own initiative bt speak these things as the Father taught Me."

John 14:10

Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father is in Me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on My own initiative, but the Father abiding in Me does His works.

B. Jesus lived in obedience to the Father's will (v.4)

Philippians 2:8

Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

2. The Father is glorified through our faith in His Son (vv.6-8)

- A. We believe because of the Father's character (v.6)
- B. We believe because of the Son's revelation. (vv.7-8)

3. The Father is glorified through His love for us. (vv.9-13)

- A. He delivers us. (vv.9-10)
- B. He protects us. (vv.11-103)

Jude 24-25
