Titus 3:1-7

1. Remember your before and after

A. No longer **obstinate to authority**, BUT NOW **willing to be under authority**.

Titus 2:1-3

Remind them **to be subject to rulers, to authorities, to be obedient**, to be ready for every good deed, to malign no one, to be peaceable, gentle, showing every consideration for all men. For we also once were foolish ourselves, **disobedient, deceived**, enslaved to various lusts and pleasures, spending our life in malice and envy, hateful, hating one another.

Romans 13:1

Every person is to be in subjection to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those which exist are established by God.

Colossians 1:16

For by Him all things were created, both in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities - all things have been created through Him and for Him.

B. No longer **trapped by evil**, BUT NOW **freed to do good**.

Titus 2:1-3

For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.

C. No longer **tearing others down**, BUT NOW **building each other up**.

i. Embodied and displayed the kindness of God and His love for mankind

ii. Is the Mediator of the gift of the Holy Spirit

iii. Savior
