1. Who We are

Deuteronomy 7:7-9

Our unique identity in Christ:

1. A Chosen Race - "I am chosen by God."

John 15:16

- 2. A Royal Priesthood "I am called and enabled to serve God."
- 3. A Holy Nation "I am holy, set apart for God's glory."
- 4. A People for God's Own Possession "I belong to the Creator."

- <u>proclaim</u> = lit. "tell out" or "tell forth" to advertise; to tell something otherwise unknown
- <u>excellencies</u> = the excellent attributes of God His mighty deeds and saving acts -to declare to others; to advertise to the world His ability to perform heroic and powerful deeds
