1. Bitter and Cruel

Habakkuk 1:6

- **fierce** - bitter cruelty
- **impetuous** - someone who acts impulsively, suddenly, quickly without warning

2. Dreaded and Feared

Habakkuk 1:7

- **dreaded** - awesome and terrible
- **feared** - the majestic sight of a huge army

God says the Chaldeans were

3. Vicious and Cunning

God says the Chaldeans were

4. Violent and Destructive

Jeremiah 18:17

Like an east wind I will scatter them before the enemy

Ezekiel 17:10

Behold, though it is planted, will it thrive? Will it not completely wither as soon as the east wind strikes it

Ezekiel 19:12

But it was plucked up in fury; it was cast down to the ground; and the east wind dried up its fruit. Its strong branch was torn off so that it withered; the fire consumed it.

Jonah 4:8

When the sun came up God appointed a scorching east wind, and the sun beat down on Jonah's head so that he became faint and begged with all his soul to die, saying, "Death is better to me than life."

God says the Chaldeans were 5. Arrogant and Fearless

Habakkuk 1:10

- **heap up rubble** - ramps built against the city walls in order to attack and plunder

Romans 2:1

Therefore you have no excuse, everyone of you who passes judgment, for in that which you judge another, you condemn yourself; for you who judge practice the same things.

Galatians 5:19-21

19. Now the deeds of the flesh are evident, which are: immorality, impurity, sensuality,

20. idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger, disputes, dissensions, factions

21. envying, drunkenness, carousing, and things like these, of which I forewarn you, just as I have forewarned you, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.
