## **1. Praising Instead of Pouting**

### **Psalm 40**

2. He brought me up out of the pit of destruction, out of the miry clay, and He set my feet upon a rock making my footsteps firm.
3. He put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to our God; many will see and fear and will trust in the LORD.
4. How blessed is the man who has made the LORD his trust, and has not turned to the proud, nor to those who lapse into falsehood.

### **Habakkuk 3:2 (NET)**

LORD, I have heard the report of what you did; I am awed, LORD, by what you accomplished.

## **2. Invoking Instead of Insulting**

### Habakkuk 3:2

- **revive** - to bring something back to life

### **Isaiah 28:21**

For the LORD will rise up as at Mount Perazim, He will be stirred up as in the valley of Gibeon, to do His task, His unusual task, and to work His work, His extraordinary work...

### **Habakkuk 3:2 (NET)**

LORD, I have heard the report of what you did; I am awed, LORD, by what you accomplished. In our time repeat those deeds; in our time reveal them again.

### Habakkuk 3:20

- **known** - to be understood
- **wrath** - coming judgment by the Chaldeans
- **mercy** - compassion
