- The Pharisees were more prone to criticism than care or compassion
- The Pharisees were more prone to condemnation than forgiveness

compassion (v. 13) - an attitude toward a need that is compelled to take action to meet that need

**4. Our Story**

- a. You are never too "bad" for Jesus, but you can be too "good".
- b. Christ-followers reflect His compassion.
