Acts 17:10-12

#### 2 Timothy 3:16

All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching...

#### Luke 8:15

...but the seed in the good soil, these are the ones who have heard the word in an honest and good heart, and hold it fast, and bear fruit with perseverance

#### Acts 17:10 -12

10. The brethren immediately sent Paul and Silas away by night to Berea, and when they arrived, they went into the synagogue of the Jews.

11. Now these were more **noble-minded** than those in Thessalonica, for they received the Word with **great eagerness**, **examining** the scripture **daily** to see whether these things were so.

12. Therefore **many** of them **believed**, along with a number of prominent Greek women and men.

#### Acts 17:11

**noble-minded** -*eugenes* - from good genes; of a good family

### 1. Eagerness to Hear from God

#### Acts 17:11

**received** - *dechomai* - idea of acceptance; to embrace

**eagerness** - to have your mind or passion toward

**great** - *pas* - full or complete

#### John 7:17

If anyone is willing to do His will, he will know of the teaching, whether it is of God or whether I speak from Myself

#### Jeremiah 29:13

You will seek Me and find Me when you search for Me with all your heart.

## 2. Carefulness To Check It Out for Ourselves

Acts 17:11

**examining** - *anakrino* - to scrutinize; to sift up and down  
**daily** - daily

## 3. Willingness To Act On What It Says

Acts 17:12

**believed** - put their trust in  
**many** - some did NOT
