



Return My Best or My Leftovers? Malachi 1:6-14

1. Our God is great and greatly to be praised.
2. Our worship is reflective of our heart and attitude toward God and His great name.
3. God does not settle for our leftovers nor find satisfaction in half-hearted “worship.”
4. We, as believers, are priests through Christ.

1 Peter 2:5

...a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

“Sacrifices” we are to bring to Him:

a. Our bodies

Romans 12:1

Therefore I urge you.. to present your bodies as a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship.

b. Offerings

Philippians 4:14-18

...a fragrant aroma, an acceptable sacrifice, well-pleasing to God.

c. Praise

Hebrews 13:15

...let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of the lips that give thanks to His name.

d. Good works

Hebrews 13:16

And do not neglect doing good and sharing, for with such sacrifices God is pleased.

e. Souls won to Christ

Romans 15:16

to be a minister of Christ Jesus to the Gentiles, ministering as a priest the gospel of God, so that my offering of the Gentiles may become acceptable...
