

Numbers 15:37-41

- 37. The Lord also spoke to Moses, saying,
- 38. "Speak to the sons of Israel, and tell them that they shall make for themselves tassels on the corners of their garments throughout their generations, and that they shall put on the tassel of each corner a cord of blue.
- 39. "It shall be a tassel for you to look at and remember all the commandments of the Lord, so as to do them and not follow after your own heart and your own eyes, after which you played the harlot,
- 30. so that you may remember to do all My commandments and be holy to your God.
- 41. "I am the Lord your God who brought you out from the land of Egypt to be your God; I am the Lord your God."

Psalm 119:9-16

- 9. How can a young man keep his way pure? By keeping it according to Your word.
- 10. With all my heart I have sought You; Do not let me wander from Your commandments.
- 11. Your word I have treasured in my heart, that I may not sin against You.
- 12. Blessed are You, O Lord; Teach me Your statutes.
- 13. With my lips I have told of all the ordinances of Your mouth.
- 14. I have rejoiced in the way of Your testimonies, as much as in all riches.
- 15. I will meditate on Your precepts and regard Your ways.

Belief Statement: Our life is inseparable and secure in Christ.

Galatians 2:20

I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

Revelation 19:7-8

- 7. "Let us rejoice and be glad and give the glory to Him, for the marriage of the Lamb has come and HIs bride has made herself ready."
- 8. It was given to her to clothe herself in fine linen, bright and clean; for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints.

Belief Statement: In Christ, believers are clothed in salvation and righteousness.

Acts 19:10

Acts 19:17

Power - dunamis - achieving power

Working - energas - active power

Strength - kratos - manifested power

Might - ischus - inherent power

Ephesians 3:13

Therefore I ask you not to lose heart at my tribulations on your behalf, for they are for your glory.

Belief Statement: God's purpose for tribulation is glory not destruction.

3. The Spirit - the inner man (Ephesians 3:16-19)

Revelation 2:1

- 1. "To the angel of the church in Ephesus write: The One who holds the seven stars in His right hand, the seven golden lamp stands, says this:
- 2. "I know your deeds and your toil and perseverance, and that you cannot tolerate evil men, and you put to the test those who call themselves apostles, and they are not, and you found them to be false;
- 3. and you have perseverance and have endured for My name's sake, and have not grown weary.
- 4. "But I have this against you, that you have left your first love.
- 5. "Therefore remember from where you have fallen, and repent and do the deeds you did at first; or else I am coming to you and will remove your lamp stand out of its place unless you repent.
- 6. "Yet this you do have, that you hate the deeds of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate.
- 7. "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes, I will grant to eat of the tree of life which is in the Paradise of God."
