What should we pray?

- 4:6 "by prayer and supplication"

- means to pray specifically

Phil 4:6 "let your requests be made known"

- aiteo: to ask inferior to superior

- plural

erotao

- equal asking and equal

- only used when Jesus is asking of the Father

Phil 4:6 "let your requests be made known"

- definite article: specific

- present tense: continuously, way of life

Phil 4:7 "...will guard your hearts and minds"

- military term: soldiers on guard duty
- future, conditional: if you make requests known
