

## Message 3: Faith Gives God the Glory

### Point 1: Faith Recognizes Where My \_\_\_\_\_ Comes From.

*<sup>17</sup>After Abram returned from defeating Chedorlaomer and the kings who were with him, the king of Sodom went out to meet him...<sup>18</sup>King Melchizedek of Salem brought out bread and wine; he was a priest to God Most High."<sup>19</sup>He blessed him and said: 'Abram is blessed by God Most High, Creator of heaven and earth, and blessed be God Most High who has handed over your enemies to you.'<sup>20</sup>And Abram gave him a tenth of everything. (Genesis 14:17–20)*

### Point 2: Faith Refuses to Take \_\_\_\_\_ That Belongs to God.

*Then the king of Sodom said to Abram, 'Give me the people, but take the possessions for yourself.' But Abram said to the king of Sodom, 'I have raised my hand in an oath to the Lord, God Most High, Creator of heaven and earth, that I will not take a thread or sandal strap or anything that belongs to you, so you can never say, 'I made Abram rich.'  
(Genesis 14:21–23)*
