

The Christmas Promise – Part 3: The Promise Fulfilled

👉 **How can we trust God's promises—especially when the waiting is hard?**

POINT 1: Trust God's _____ Matthew 1:18-20

¹⁸"The birth of Jesus Christ came about this way: After his mother Mary had been engaged to Joseph, it was discovered before they came together that she was pregnant from the Holy Spirit." ¹⁹"So her husband Joseph, being a righteous man, and not wanting to disgrace her publicly, decided to divorce her secretly." ²⁰"But after he had considered these things, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, 'Joseph, son of David, don't be afraid to take Mary as your wife, because what has been conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit.'"

POINT 2: Believe God's _____ Matthew 1:21-23

²¹"She will give birth to a son, and you are to name him Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." ²²"Now all this took place to fulfill what was spoken by the Lord through the prophet:" ²³"See, the virgin will become pregnant and give birth to a son, and they will name him Immanuel," which is translated 'God is with us.'"

POINT 3: Walk in _____ Matthew 1:24-25

²⁴"When Joseph woke up, he did as the Lord's angel had commanded him. He married her..." ²⁵"but did not have sexual relations with her until she gave birth to a son. And he named him Jesus."

Take Home Truth: Jesus is the fulfillment of God's greatest _____ to the world.
