 Text: Exodus 3:1–12 (CSB)

How should I respond when God calls me out of my comfort zone?

Point 1: Notice God in Your _____.

"Meanwhile, Moses was shepherding the flock of his father-in-law Jethro, the priest of Midian. He led the flock to the far side of the wilderness and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. Then the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a flame of fire within a bush. As Moses looked, he saw that the bush was on fire but was not consumed. So Moses thought: I must go over and look at this remarkable sight..."
(Exodus 3:1–3, CSB)

Point 2: Care About Who God _____.

"Then the Lord said, 'I have observed the misery of my people in Egypt, and have heard them crying out because of their oppressors, and I know about their sufferings. I have come down to rescue them... Therefore, go. I am sending you to Pharaoh so that you may lead my people, the Israelites, out of Egypt.'" (Exodus 3:7–10, CSB)

Point 3: Trust God's Presence More Than Your _____.

"But Moses asked God, 'Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh and that I should bring the Israelites out of Egypt?' He answered, 'I will certainly be with you...'" (Exodus 3:11–12, CSB)
