The Covenant-Keeping God
Romans 11:25-36

Main Idea: Because God always keeps His promises, we can trust His saving plan and worship His glorious name.

Introduction:

- If Israel rejected Christ, have God's promises failed?
- If Israel has experienced this hardening, has God abandoned the promises He made to His people?

God Reveals His Redemptive Plan - vv.25-27

- God's truth is received through humility - **v.25a**
 - **Isaiah 55:8-9**
- God's plan is revealed, not discovered - **v.25b**
- God's plan includes future mercy for Israel - **vv.26-27**
 - **Hebrews 10:23**

God Displays His Covenant Faithfulness - vv.28-32

- God's covenant is greater than man's failure - **vv.28-29**
 - **Philippians 1:6**
- God's mercy is the only hope for every sinner - **vv.30-32**
- God's faithfulness gives us humility and hope
 - What should this truth produce in us?
 - First it should produce _____

Therefore...Worship The God Who Saves - vv.33-36

- Worship God humbly, because His wisdom is beyond us - **v.33**
 - **Micah 6:8**
- Worship God gratefully, because His Grace is completely free - **vv.34-35**
- Worship God completely, because His Glory is the goal of everything - **v.36**
