God's Sovereign Will

Romans 9:19-29

Main Idea: *God is perfectly righteous in exercising His Sovereign will because He is the Creator, the Revealer of His glory, and the One who graciously calls the undeserving*

Introduction:

God Has The Right Over His Creation - vv.19-21

- Man's objection - **v.19**
- God's response - **v.20a**
 - **Job 38:1–3; Job 38:4–5; Job 42:2; Job 42:5–6**
- God's authority - **vv.20b-21a**
 - **Isaiah 29:16; Isaiah 45:9**
- God's mercy - **v.21b**

God Has The Right To Demonstrate His Glory - vv.22-24

- God's Glory is revealed in His justice - **v.22**
 - **Psalms 7:11**
- God's Glory is revealed in His mercy - **vv.23-24**
 - **Ephesians 2:4**

God Has The Right To Call The Undeserving - vv.25-29

- God's Grace reaches the unlikely - **vv.25-26**
- God's Grace preserves a remnant - **vv.27-28**
- God's Grace is the only reason anyone is saved - **v.29**
