**Salvation To All Who Believe**  
**Romans 10:5-21**

**Main Idea:** *Because Christ has accomplished everything necessary for Salvation, everyone who believes in Him will be saved. And, God brings people to that Faith through the proclamation of the Gospel.*

**Introduction:**

- Ever since Genesis 3, every person has been trying to answer the same question:
  - How can a sinful person be accepted by the Holy God?
- If I could summarize this entire passage with one question, it would simply be this:
  - How does God's righteousness become mine?

**Christ Has Already Accomplished Our Salvation - vv. 5-8**

- The law demands perfect righteousness - **v. 5**
  - **Leviticus 18:5; Matthew 5:48; Romans 3:20**
- Christ has fulfilled what the law could never produce - **vv. 6-8**
  - How does God's righteousness become ours?

**Faith Alone Receives Christ's Salvation - vv. 9-13**

- Saving faith trusts Christ from the heart - **v. 9**
- Saving faith publicly confesses Christ as Lord - **vv. 9b-10**
- Saving faith receives God's promise - **vv. 11-13**
  - How does anyone come to call upon Christ?

**God Ordains The Proclamation Of The Gospel - vv. 14-17**

- God sends His people to proclaim the Gospel - **vv. 14-15a**
- God delights in those who carry the Gospel - **v. 15b**
- God creates faith through His Word - **vv. 16-17**
  - Why did so many in Israel still reject Christ?

## **God Is Just In Humanity's Rejection Of The Gospel - vv.18-21**

- Israel heard the Gospel - **v. 18**
- Israel understood the Gospel, but rejected it - **vv. 19-20**
- God's hands remain outstretched - **v. 21**
