The Unwavering Faithfulness Of God
Romans 11:1-10

***Main Idea:** God's rejection of unbelieving Israel is neither total nor final; because He always remains faithful to His covenant purposes through Sovereign Grace.*

Introduction:

- If God is always faithful... Why do people sometimes question His faithfulness?

God's Faithfulness Is Seen In His Covenant People - vv. 1-2a

- The question that challenges God's faithfulness - **v.1a**
- The answer that declares God's faithfulness - **v.1b**
 - **Romans 3:3-4**
- The testimony that confirms God's faithfulness - **v.1c**
- The foundation of God's faithfulness - **v.2a**
 - How has God demonstrated that faithfulness throughout history?

God's Faithfulness Is Revealed Through His Sovereign Grace - vv. 2b-6

- God's perspective is greater than ours - **vv. 2b-4**
- God's Grace has always preserved His people - **v.5**
- God's Grace leaves no room for boasting - **vv.5b-6**

Therefore... God's Faithfulness Calls Us To Humble Confidence - vv.7-11

- Be humbled by God's Grace - **v.7**
 - **1 Corinthians 4:7**
- Take seriously the danger of a hardened heart - **v.7b**
- Rest securely in the faithfulness of God - **vv.8-10**
