Observation

- What contrasts do you see?

Interpretation

- What did this mean to the original audience?
- What does "be anxious for nothing" mean?
- What is the "peace of God"?
- What does Paul mean by "meditate on these things"?

Application

- What causes me anxiety?
- How can prayer replace worry?
- What should I intentionally think about?
- How can I practice these truths this week?

The Three Tools to Master First

- Factbook – "Tell me about this."
- Search – "Where does the Bible talk about this?"
- Layouts-How Do I Organize My Desktop?"
