SUMMER NIGHTS | AUG 5 | 6:30-8:30pm

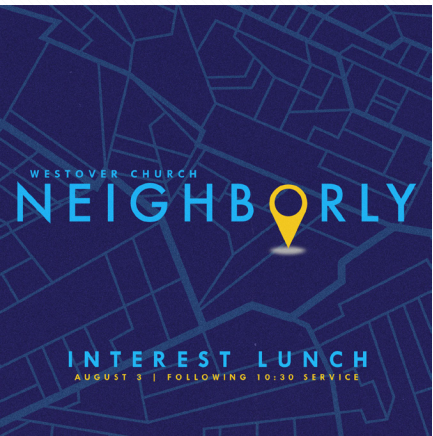
