Vision: Remove lies & plant truth

James 3:18 "And those who are peacemakers will plant seeds of peace & reap a harvest of righteousness."

Attune: meeting children on their level.

Romans 12:16 AMPC "Live in harmony with one another; do not be haughty (snobbish, high-minded exclusive), but readily adjust yourself to {people, things} & give yourselves to humble tasks. Never overestimate yourself or be wise in your own conceits."

Adapt: modify or alter/adjust yourself

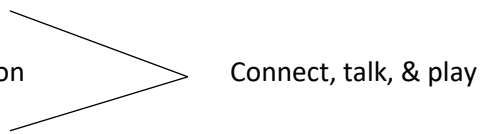
Serve & return: responsive interactions between children & leaders & how those interactions help children grow & reach their full potential.

Peek-a-boo-memory & trust

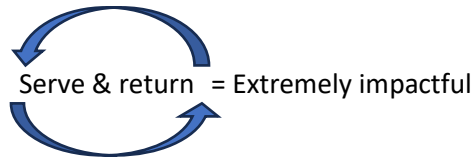


2 Corinthians 4:5 "You see we don't go around preaching about ourselves. We preach that Jesus Christ is Lord & we ourselves are your servants for Jesus' sake."

Interacting builds & strengthens relationships/mental health, & life skills

2 Corinthians 4:6-7 "For God, who said "Let there be light in the darkness," has made this glory shine in our hearts so we could know the glory of God... We now have this light shining in our hearts, but we ourselves are like fragile clay jars containing this great treasure. This makes it clear that our great power is from God, not from ourselves."

Leadership is influence and trust.

Romans 11:5-6 TPT "... for a few people in Israel have remained faithful because of God's grace, his undeserved kindness in choosing them. And since it is through God's kindness, then it is not by their good works. For in that case, God's grace would not be what it really is-free & undeserved."

Romans 2:8-9 TPT " For by grace you have been saved by faith. Nothing you did could ever earn this salvation, for it was the love gift from God that brought us to Christ! So no one will ever be able to boast, for salvation is never a reward for good works or human striving."

John 15:5 TPT "...but when you live separated from me you can do nothing"

2 Corinthians 4:15-18 NLT "All of this is for your benefit. As God's grace reaches more & more people, there will be great thanksgiving, & God will receive more & more glory. That is why we never give up. For our present troubles are small & won't last very long. Yet they produce for us a glory that vastly outweighs them & will last forever! So, we don't look at troubles we see now; rather, we fix our gaze on things that cannot be seen. For things we see now will soon be gone but the things we cannot see will last forever!"
