The Year of Jubilee

Luke 4:18-19 (NASB 2020) "THE SPIRIT OF THE LORD IS UPON ME, BECAUSE HE ANOINTED ME TO BRING GOOD NEWS TO THE POOR. HE HAS SENT ME TO PROCLAIM RELEASE TO CAPTIVES, AND RECOVERY OF SIGHT TO THE BLIND, TO SET FREE THOSE WHO ARE OPPRESSED, TO PROCLAIM THE FAVORABLE YEAR OF THE LORD."

I. Jesus delivered us once and for all! The Sabbath

Exodus 20:8 (ESV) "Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy."

Leviticus 25:10 (NLT) Set this year apart as holy, a time to proclaim freedom throughout the land for all who live there. It will be a jubilee year for you, when each of you may return to the land that belonged to your ancestors and return to your own clan.

Luke 4:18-19 (NASB 2020) ...HE HAS SENT ME TO PROCLAIM RELEASE TO CAPTIVES.... RECOVERY OF SIGHT TO THE BLIND.... TO SET FREE THOSE WHO ARE OPPRESSED, TO PROCLAIM THE FAVORABLE YEAR OF THE LORD."

Matthew 12:8 (NASB 2020) For the Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath."

****Hebrews 4:3 (NASB 2020)** For we who have believed enter that rest, just as He has said, "AS I SWORE IN MY ANGER, THEY CERTAINLY SHALL NOT ENTER MY REST," although His works were finished from the foundation of the world.

Matthew 11:28-29 (NASB 2020) "Come to Me, all who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and YOU WILL FIND REST FOR YOUR SOULS."

II. Satan has no power.

John 12:31 (NASB95) "Now judgment is upon this world; now the ruler of this world will be cast out."

***Matthew 12:29 (NASB95)** "Or how can anyone enter the strong man's house and carry off his property, unless he first binds the strong man? And then he will plunder his house."

Colossians 2:15 (NLT) In this way, He disarmed the spiritual rulers and authorities. He shamed them publicly by His victory over them on the cross.

Colossians 2:20 (NLT) You have died with Christ, and he has set you free from the spiritual powers of this world.

Philippians 2:9-10 (NLT) Therefore, God elevated him to the place of highest honor and gave him the name above all other names, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth,

Ephesians 1:21-22 (NLT) Now He is far above any ruler or authority or power or leader or anything else—not only in this world but also in the world to come. God has put all things under the authority of Christ and has made Him head over all things for the benefit of the church.

III. We Have the Power and Authority

Ephesians 2:6 (NLT) For He raised us from the dead along with Christ and seated us with Him in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 3:10 (NLT) God's purpose in all this was to use the church to display His wisdom in its rich variety to all the unseen rulers and authorities in the heavenly places.

John 14:12-13 (NKJV) "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father. And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask anything in My name, I will do it."

2 Peter 1:3-4 (ESV) His divine power has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of him who called us to his own glory and excellence, by which he has granted to us his precious and very great promises, so that through them you may become partakers of the divine nature, having escaped from the corruption that is in the world because of sinful desire.

1 Corinthians 4:20 (NLT) For the Kingdom of God is not just a lot of talk; it is living by God's power.

Luke 9:1-2 (NLT) One day Jesus called together his twelve disciples and gave them power and authority to cast out all demons and to heal all diseases. Then he sent them out to tell everyone about the Kingdom of God and to heal the sick.

Matthew 10:7-8 (NASB 2020) And as you go, preach, saying, 'The kingdom of heaven has come near.' Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those with leprosy, cast out demons. Freely you received, freely give.

Luke 10:17 (NASB 2020) Now the seventy-two returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name!"

Acts 1:8 (NASB 2020) but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem and in all Judea, and Samaria, and as far as the remotest part of the earth."
