- 1) Take some time to discuss how your IC has been and will live out the Kingdom of Jesus together.
- In what ways have we been living like family recently? How will we live out our family identity in the coming week?
- How have we lived as servants to one another or to our world this past week? What needs or opportunities to serve is God is asking us to lean into?
- How have we lived on mission where we live, work, play, or went this past week? Who do we know that needs to hear the good news of Jesus?

2) What did you find most significant about this message? How did it encourage you and challenge you?

3) Read 1 Corinthians 14:1-33. What strikes you about this passage and what questions does it raise for you?

4) What do we learn about prophecy from this passage? What do we learn about tongues? Make a list of the benefits of both spiritual gifts? How should these gifts be exercised in the church?

5) Note the number of times Paul uses the words "strengthened" and "understanding" in 1 Cor. 14. What is the relationship between these two concepts and why does this matter? How does the Bible relate to this today?

6) Read 1 John 1:14 and Hebrews 1:1-3. It what way do these passages reveal God "speaking to us" and what does this tell us about God and about ourselves? How does the the Gospel undergird our desire for spiritual gifts and our use of spiritual gifts?

7) What action steps do you need this week to take to develop a "listening posture"?

8) Take some time to pray for spiritual gifts (like prophecy) so that you can strengthen others. What steps do you need to take to exercise your spiritual gifts in love, maintaining unity within the church?

God speaks so we can <u>know</u> Him, <u>love</u> Him, and <u>serve</u> Him.

Discussion on spiritual gifts and unity from 1 Corinthians 12-14:

- Spiritual gifts are to elevate Christ and edify others. (1 Cor. 12:1-11)
- Seek to operate holistically within the body of Christ as you fulfill your role. 1 Cor. 12:12-31)
- Pursue the love of Christ to love like Christ. (1 Cor. 13)
- Seek and exercise spiritual gifts so others are strengthened. (1 Cor. 14)

1 Corinthians 14:1-25

Big Idea: <u>Seek</u> and <u>exercise</u> spiritual gifts so others are <u>strengthened</u>. How do we do this?

1) Seek spiritual gifts that strengthen the whole church.

v. 6 "Dear brothers and sisters, if I should come to you speaking in an unknown language, how would that help you? But if I bring you a revelation or some special knowledge or prophecy or teaching, that will be helpful."

• Understanding is required for people to be strengthened.

v. 12 "Since you are so eager to have the special abilities the Spirit gives, seek those that will strengthen the whole church."

2) Exercise spiritual gifts in a well-ordered way to strengthen others.

1 Corinthians 14:26-33 Well, my brothers and sisters, let's summarize. When you meet together, one will sing, another will teach, another will tell some special revelation God has given, one will speak in tongues, and another will interpret what is said. But everything that is done must strengthen all of you. ²⁷ No more than two or three should speak in tongues. They must speak one at a time, and someone must interpret what they say. ²⁸ But if no one is present who can interpret, they must be silent in your church meeting and speak in tongues to God privately. ²⁹ Let two or three people prophesy, and let the others evaluate what is said. ³⁰ But if someone is prophesying and another person receives a revelation from the Lord, the one who is speaking must stop. ³¹ In this way, all who prophesy will have a turn to speak, one after the other, so that everyone will learn and be encouraged.³² Remember that people who prophesy are in control of their spirit and can take turns. ³³ For God is not a God of disorder but of peace, as in all the meetings of God's holy people.

John 1:14 "So the Word became human and made his home among us. He was full of unfailing love and faithfulness. And we have seen his glory, the glory of the Father's one and only Son."

Hebrews 1:1-3 "Long ago God spoke many times and in many ways to our ancestors through the prophets. ² And now in these final days, he has spoken to us through his Son. God promised everything to the Son as an inheritance, and through the Son he created the universe. ³ The Son radiates God's own glory and expresses the very character of God, and he sustains everything by the mighty power of his command. When he had cleansed us from our sins, he sat down in the place of honour at the right hand of the majestic God in heaven."

Action Steps:

- Cultivate a listening posture.
- Pray for and exercise the gift of prophecy to strengthen others.
