Honouring our Parents

Ephesians 6:1-4

Children, obey your parents because you belong to the Lord, for this is the right thing to do. ² "Honor your father and mother." This is the first commandment with a promise: ³ If you honor your father and mother, "things will go well for you, and you will have a long life on the earth."

⁴ Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger by the way you treat them. Rather, bring them up with the discipline and instruction that comes from the Lord.

- Family is God's idea.
- The job of a parent: to "bring them up" (v.4)
 - With discipline

For our earthly fathers disciplined us for a few years, doing the best they knew how. But God's discipline is always good for us, so that we might share in his holiness. ¹¹ No discipline is enjoyable while it is happening—it's painful! But afterward there will be a peaceful harvest of right living for those who are trained in this way. (Hebrews 12:10-11)

• With instruction

I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you and watch over you. (Psalm 32:8, NIV)

How are children to treat their parents?

Children and youth: **obey them** (v. 1)

The all-encompassing principle: **honour them.** (v. 2)

"Honor your father and mother. Then you will live a long, full life in the land the Lord your God is giving you" (Exodus 20:12)

To Honour is:

- not a **feeling**, but an **action**.
- not based on <u>emotion</u>, but on <u>decision</u>.
- not according to merit, but according to their God-given role.

Big Idea: Honouring our parents is the right thing to do.

This week:

- Look to God to be the true parent you need.
- Think about what **would** honour your parents.
- Take action.
