- 4. In the message it was said, "You can't grow in a relationship with Jesus, experience inner transformation, or have a Kingdom impact in the world on your own. You need an authentic, Christ-centred, Kingdom-first community." What reasons were given for this?
- 5. Reflect on the quote: "The person who loves their dream of community will destroy community, but the person who loves those around them will create community." (Dietrich Bonhoeffer in *Life Together.*)
- 6. Take some time to discuss how your IC has been and will live out the Kingdom of Jesus together.
 - In what ways have we been living like family recently? How will we live out our family identity in the coming week?
 - How have we lived as servants to one another or to our world this past week? What needs or opportunities to serve is God is asking us to lean into?

Big Idea: The Kingdom LIFE can only be lived out in Kingdom COMMUNITY.

1. What is a Kingdom Community?

Simplest form: A community of people centred on JESUS and his KINGDOM.

Acts 2:42-47 All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, and to fellowship, and to sharing in meals (including the Lord's Supper), and to prayer. $^{43}\,\mathrm{A}$ deep sense of awe came over them all, and the apostles performed many miraculous signs and wonders. $^{44}\,\mathrm{And}$ all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had. $^{45}\,\mathrm{They}$ sold their property and possessions and shared the money with those in need. $^{46}\,\mathrm{They}$ worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity— $^{47}\,\mathrm{all}$ the while praising God and enjoying the goodwill of all the people. And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved.

"A community of inclusive belonging where God's alternative Kingdom can be experienced. A community of belonging, benevolence, and blessing to the world."

2. Why is Kingdom Community essential to following Jesus?

• GOD is community. (John 1:1, Matthew 28:19)

• Humans were **CREATED** for community. (Genesis 2:18)

· We GROW only in community.

 The Christian identity <u>REQUIRES</u> community. (2 Corinthians 5:17, Matthew 28:18-20)

3. How does Kingdom Community happen?

- When we stop seeking to <u>USE</u> community.
- When we realize it's not something **WE CREATE**.
- When we understand, embrace, and choose to live out our <u>NEW</u> <u>IDENTITY</u> with others.
