It seems that God has created us in a way where we are made to <u>imitate</u>. But who are we to imitate?

Ephesians 5:1-2 (NLT) Imitate God, therefore, in everything you do, because you are his dear children.² Live a life filled with love, following the example of Christ. He loved us and offered himself as a sacrifice for us, a pleasing aroma to God.

Big Idea: Imitate God and live a life filled with love. How do we do this?

· Jesus is our motive.

John 10:10 (NLT) "The thief's purpose is to steal and kill and destroy. My purpose is to give them a rich and satisfying life."

1 John 4:19 (NIV) "We love because he first loved us."

- · Jesus is our model.
- Love is displayed as self-sacrificing service.

• Jesus is our means.

Romans 8:1-8 (NLT) So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus. ² And because you belong to him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death. ³ The law of Moses was unable to save us because of the weakness of our sinful nature. So God did what the law could not do. He sent his own Son in a body like the bodies we sinners have. And in that body God declared an end to sin's control over us by giving his Son as a sacrifice for our sins. ⁴ He did this so that the just requirement of the law would be fully satisfied for us, who no longer follow our sinful nature but instead follow the Spirit. ⁵ Those who are dominated by the sinful nature think about sinful things, but those who are controlled by the Holy Spirit think about things that please the Spirit. ⁶ So letting your sinful nature control your mind leads to death. But letting the Spirit control your mind leads to life and peace.

But how do we practically live this life of love in community at Sequoia?

- Impact Communities are our method.
- Within Impact Communities we live out our <u>identity</u> as a Family of Servants on Mission.

- Receive the love and grace of God found in Jesus Christ.
- Find your <u>place</u> within an Impact Community.
