#### **The Power of the Spirit**

1 Corinthians 2:1-5 "When I first came to you, dear brothers and sisters, I didn't use lofty words and impressive wisdom to tell you God's secret plan. <sup>2</sup> For I decided that while I was with you I would forget everything except Jesus Christ, the one who was crucified. <sup>3</sup> I came to you in weakness—timid and trembling. <sup>4</sup> And my message and my preaching were very plain. Rather than using clever and persuasive speeches, I relied only on the power of the Holy Spirit. <sup>5</sup> I did this so you would trust not in human wisdom but in the power of God."

Big Idea: God has given us the <u>Holy Spirit</u> to lead us into a <u>dynamic</u>, <u>personal relationship</u> with Jesus Christ.

1. The Holy Spirit Empowers Us.

2. The Holy Spirit Helps Us.

3. The Holy Spirit Points Us to Jesus.

In John 17:3 Jesus said: "Now this is eternal life: that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent." (NIV)
