Isaiah 41:8-10 (NLT) "But as for you, Israel my servant, Jacob my chosen one, descended from Abraham my friend, 9 I have called you back from the ends of the earth, saying, 'You are my servant.' For I have chosen you and will not throw you away. 10 Don't be afraid, for I am with you. Don't be discouraged, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you. I will hold you up with my victorious right hand."

Isaiah 53:5-6,10, 11-12 (NLT) But he was pierced for our rebellion, crushed for our sins. He was beaten so we could be whole. He was whipped so we could be healed. ⁶ All of us, like sheep, have strayed away. We have left God's paths to follow our own. Yet the Lord laid on him the sins of us all... ¹⁰ But it was the Lord's good plan to crush him and cause him grief. Yet when his life is made an offering for sin, he will have many descendants... When he sees all that is accomplished by his anguish, he will be satisfied. ¹¹ And because of his experience, my righteous servant will make it possible for many to be counted righteous, for he will bear all their sins. ¹² I will give him the honours of a victorious soldier, because he exposed himself to death. He was counted among the rebels. He bore the sins of many and interceded for rebels.

- 1) Last week we looked at Ephesians 1:3-14 and how God has chosen us to become like Him in holiness. How has the Lord been speaking to you this week? We were challenged to "Choose God" each and every day. How were you able to apply this message?
- 2) Read Isaiah 41:8-10. What is the **Context** for this passage? Where is this taking place in the book as a whole (what comes before or after)? Who is the writer and who are the recipients? Where does it fit in the Bible? What's the theme of this chapter, or passage? What's the historical and cultural context?
- 3) **Observation:** What "jumps out" in this passages? What interesting details do you observe? What questions come up about the passage? What is the major theme in the passage?
- 4) **Meaning:** What was the meaning for the original recipients? What meaning is inferred in this passage for us and what does this tell us about our identity in Christ?
- 5) What promise from God in this passage is most significant for you and why?
- 6) Read Isaiah 53:1-12. In what way does the Messiah serve us through his suffering? How does Christ's suffering give us victory & hope today?
- 7) **Application:** How is God speaking to you through this study? (Take some time for Listening Prayer). In what way is God asking you to embrace your identity as His servant?
- 8) What would it look like for you to "give yourself away for the Kingdom"? Where and to whom is God asking you serve today?



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
