Honouring God with our Gender Differences

1 Corinthians 11:1-16 (NLT) And you should imitate me, just as I imitate Christ.
² I am so glad that you always keep me in your thoughts, and that you are following the teachings I passed on to you.³ But there is one thing I want you to know: The head of every man is Christ, the head of woman is man, and the head of Christ is God.⁴ A man dishonours his head if he covers his head while praying or prophesying.⁵ But a woman dishonours her head if she prays or prophesies without a covering on her head, for this is the same as shaving her head.⁶ Yes, if she refuses to wear a head covering, she should cut off all her hair! But since it is shameful for a woman to have her hair cut or her head shaved, she should wear a covering.⁷ A man should not wear anything on his head when worshiping, for man is made in God's image and reflects God's glory. And woman reflects man's glory.⁸ For the first man didn't come from woman, but the first woman came from man.⁹ And man was not made for woman, but woman was made for man.¹⁰ For this reason, and because the angels are watching, a woman should wear a covering on her head to show she is under authority.¹¹ But among the Lord's people, women are not independent of men, and men are not independent of women.¹² For although the first woman came from man, every other man was born from a woman, and everything comes from God.¹³ Judge for yourselves. Is it right for a woman to pray to God in public without covering her head?¹⁴ Isn't it obvious that it's disgraceful for a man to have long hair?¹⁵ And isn't long hair a woman's pride and joy? For it has been given to her as a covering.¹⁶ But if anyone wants to argue about this, I simply say that we have no other custom than this, and neither do God's other churches.

Galatians 3:26-28 "For you are all children of God through faith in Christ Jesus. And all who have been united with Christ in baptism have put on Christ, like putting on new clothes. There is no longer Jew or Gentile, slave or free, male for female. For you are all one in Christ Jesus."

We always want to be careful that we don't use our freedom in a way that causes others to miss Jesus or misinterpret Jesus in some way.

- **Gender difference matters and it is good.**

Genesis 2:27 "So God created human beings in his own image. In the image of God he created them; male and female he created them...31 Then God looked over all he had made, and he saw that it was very good!"

"During the 1960s, everyone remotely progressive proclaimed that the personality differences between men and women -- if they existed at all -- were merely products of social conditioning. A recent major study concluded the opposite: such differences are large and persistent. Similar results were already reported more than 10 years ago in a cross-cultural study of 20,000 participants. That study also assessed whether gender differences decreased, as predicted, in more egalitarian societies. Surely Swedish men and women would be more alike, given Sweden's commitment to equality. The opposite, however, proved true: gender differences were larger in more egalitarian societies. As society restructures, so that males and females play similar roles, the environmental difference in their treatment decreases. Ironically, this allows the genetic differences to manifest themselves more clearly."
