Big Idea: Embracing God's definition of manhood <u>unlocks</u> a life of true adventure.

What is God's definition of a real man?

Real men Lead with <u>Love</u>, Protect with <u>Courage</u>, Serve with <u>Joy</u>, and Follow Jesus.

Real Men Lead with Love.

1 John 4:7 Dear friends, let us continue to love one another, for love comes from God. Anyone who loves is a child of God and knows God.

Romans 5:8

Real Men Protect with Courage.

Joshua 1:9 This is my command—be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."

Real Men Serve with Joy.

Colossians 3:23-24 Work willingly at whatever you do, as though you were working for the Lord rather than for people. ²⁴ Remember that the Lord will give you an inheritance as your reward, and that the Master you are serving is Christ.

Real Men Follow Jesus.

Deut. 30:19-20 "Today I have given you the choice between life and death, between blessings and curses. Now I call on heaven and earth to witness the choice you make. Oh, that you would choose life, so that you and your descendants might live! You can make this choice by loving the Lord your God, obeying him, and committing yourself firmly to him. This is the key to your life. And if you love and obey the Lord, you will live long in the land the Lord swore to give your ancestors Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob."

Lord I want to be the person you have called me to be. Thank you for loving me in spite of my performance. Thank you for dying for my sin and self-centredness. Thank you for your grace and forgiveness. Thank you for your Holy Spirit who enables me to live with purpose & power. Empower me to lead with love so that the world knows you.
