## **Love Tattoo**

Isaiah 49:12-16: See, my people will return from far away, from lands to the north and west, and from as far south as Egypt"<sup>13</sup> Sing for joy, O heavens! Rejoice, O earth! Burst into song, O mountains! For the Lord has comforted his people and will have compassion on them in their suffering. <sup>14</sup> Yet Jerusalem says, "The Lord has deserted us; the Lord has forgotten us."

15 "Never! Can a mother forget her nursing child?
Can she feel no love for the child she has borne?
But even if that were possible, I would not forget you!
16 See, I have written your name on the palms of my hands.

Always in my mind is a picture of Jerusalem's walls in ruins.

Isaiah 53:5 But he was pierced for our rebellion, crushed for our sins. He was beaten so we could be whole. He was whipped so we could be healed.

1 Peter 2:24 [Jesus] Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed.

Matthew 27:45-46 (NIV) From noon until three in the afternoon darkness came over all the land. <sup>46</sup> About three in the afternoon Jesus cried out in a loud voice, "Eloi, Eloi, lema sabachthani?" (which means "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?").

Big Idea: Because God loves us we can trust Him with our whole lives!

We can trust God with our salvation.

• We can trust God with our circumstances.

We can trust God with our hearts.

• We can trust God with our future.
