Sharing the Experience - Dec 20, 2015

- 1. What's one idea from the message that stuck out to you?
- 2. Share about an adventure you experienced with someone that wouldn't have been the same if you were on your own.
- 3. Share examples of how you have seen or experienced each of the various qualities of deep relationships that were discussed in the message. Which of these relational qualities do you think are more common or rare in our society?
- 4. Read 2 Corinthians 5:17-6:1. What two things does this passage teach happens when we place our faith in Jesus? What does it mean to be "God's partners"? (6:1, NLT)
- 5. In the message it was said that a key element of partnership is having a *shared purpose*. Each Impact Community at Sequoia is encouraged to define it's own "shared purpose/mission"- whether it is a neighborhood or a sub-culture in society. What is your IC's shared purpose? How clear/specific is it? As we head into 2016, what could you do as an IC to grow your passion and commitment to the shared mission that God has for you?
- 6. Taking our relationships with God to the next level involves practicing spiritual disciplines. Visit http://www.soulshepherding.org/2012/07/spiritual-disciplines-list/ and read together through the disciplines of abstinence and the disciplines of engagement. Which spiritual discipline will you explore in the New Year to experience a deeper relationship with God?
- 7. In Acts 2:42-47 and 4:32-37 we see some powerful descriptions of how the early church lived in community with one another. Even though we don't need to copy everything about how they lived, we can learn and be inspired by them of what it can look like to live as a "family on mission." Brainstorm together some practical things your IC could do that would take your relationships with one another to the *next level*.
