

The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. 18 All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation; 19 that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. 20 Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. 21 For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

Proclamation of God's Word

22 Then Moses made Israel set out from the Red Sea, and they went into the wilderness of Shur. They went three days in the wilderness and found no water. 23 When they came to Marah, they could not drink the water of Marah because it was bitter; therefore it was named Marah. 24 And the people grumbled against Moses, saying, "What shall we drink?" 25 And he cried to the Lord, and the Lord showed him a log, and he threw it into the water, and the water became sweet. There the Lord made for them a statute and a rule, and there he tested them, 26 saying, "If you will diligently listen to the voice of the Lord your God, and do that which is right in his eyes, and give ear to his commandments and keep all his statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you that I put on the Egyptians, for I am the Lord, your healer." 27 Then they came to Elim, where there were twelve springs of water and seventy palm trees, and they encamped there by the water.

Discussion Questions

- 1. When do you grumble, and why? What does it say about your view of, and faith in, God? How seriously do you take it?
- 2. How is gospel gratitude the antidote to grumbling? Spend some time giving thanks together for specific things in your life.
- 3. Where has God turned your heart from bitter to sweet? Where do you need Him to turn your heart from bitter to sweet, and how is the gospel the power to do it?
- 4. In Philippians 4:11-13, Paul says he "learned the secret" of abounding in any and every circumstance. What is contentment? How does the gospel give us contentment?

Sermon Title: From Bitter to Sweet

I. Grumbling

Only 3 days after their miraculous rescue at the Red Sea, Israel begins to grumble. What is grumbling? Why is it so serious? What does it reveal about our hearts?

II. Grace

How does God respond to Israel's grumbling? How is this a parable for how God has responded to us in Christ?

III. Gratitude

God's kindness is meant to lead us to repentance and obedience. How does the gospel change our grumbling into a life of gratitude? How does the gospel make us content?
