Paul's second letter corrects some new errors in the church at Thessalonica



1. Circumstantial issue -Believers were experiencing great trials and afflictions through persecution



1. Circumstantial issue -Dan

Trusting God is not a result of my feelings; it's a result of my faith in God's perfect



2. Prophetical issue -A forged letter, . supposedly from the hand of Paul, declared that these believers were living in the Tribulation



3. Practical issue -There was some. disorderliness manifesting itself within the church



1. Paul's greeting - vv. 1-2 Our position in God - v. 1 Our progress in the Lord - V. 2



PSALM 1211-2 I will lift up my eyes unto the hills; from whence comes my help My help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth



2. Paul's admiration - vv. 3-4 Paul was bound to give thanks to God meaning "deep obligation"

Greek word for bound is opheilo



2. Paul's admiration - vv. 3-4 • For their faith - v. 3a Greek word for exceedingly is hyperauxano meaning "beyond what could ever be expected"



PETER 222 As new born babes, desire the pure milk of the Word, that you may grow thereby

2. Paul's admiration - vv. 3-4 • For their love - v. 3b For their steadfast hope - v. 4 Greek word for patience hupomone meaning "to remain under"
