FUNCTIONAL DEFINITION OF FAITH

1. Faith provides a foundation for my hope - v. 1a

Greek word for faith is pistis and it's a word that is used 243 times in the New Testament. It means "belief, trust, confidence or assurance"

1. Faith provides a foundation for my hope - v. 1a

Faith is based on, "the substance" This Greek word is hupostasis made up of two words: histemi which means "to cause to stand" and hupo, which means "under," or "to stand under"

Faith is to a Christian what a foundation is to a house: it gives confidence and assurance that he will stand Warren Wiersbe

2. Faith produces a conviction for the present - v. 1b

"The evidence of things not seen" The NKJV translates the Greek word elegchos as "evidence" but it could also be translated "proof or conviction"

FUNCTIONAL DEFINITION OF FAITH

3. Faith prioritizes actions worthy of approval - v. 2

"For by it the elders obtained a good testimony"

Our faith and trust fulfills its purpose by pleasing God

DANIEL 3:16-18 Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego answered and said to the king, "O Nebuchadnezzar, we have no need to answer

DANIEL 3:16-18 you in this matter. If that is the case, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery turnace,

DANIEL 3:16-18 and He will deliver us from your hand, O king. But if not, let it be known to you, O king, that we do not serve your gods,

DANIEL 3:16-18 nor will we worship the gold image which you have set up"
