B. A Call to Embrace God's Standard Regarding Sin (6-13)
1. Sin is — it spreads! (6b)
2. Sin is not to be — we have been set free! (7a)
■ We are to ourselves from sin (7a)
■ For we have in fact been from sin (7b)
■ Christ is the of God Who has died in our place (7c)
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 - The matter was to be treated with a sense of urgency (3)
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 - A response was to come with the church gathered under the direction of the spiritual leadership (4a)
 - A response was to be made by the authority of Christ (4b)
 - The protective covering of the church is to be removed (5)

B. A Call to Embrace God's Standard Regarding Sin (6-13)

- 1. Sin is **dangerous** it spreads! (6b)
- 2. Sin is not to be **tolerated** we have been set free! (7a)
 - We are to separate ourselves from sin (7a)
 - For we have in fact been cleansed from sin (7b)
 - Christ is the Lamb of God Who has died in our place (7c)
- 3. Sin is to be **eliminated** from our lives (8)
 - Israel 7 day's devoted to God for freedom from slavery
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 - The 'feast' symbolizes a life of complete devotion to God
- 4. Sin in the Church calls for a discerning response (9)
 - He warns against 'mixing closely' with the unrepentant
 - He is speaking of believers who actually embrace sin (11)
 - He calls for judgment and church discipline (12b,13b)

Personal Reflection

- 1) The goal of church discipline is twofold
 - Goal #1: Maintain purity in Christ's Church
 - Goal #2: Restore the disobedient one to repentance (2 C 2:7)

<u>Key</u>: We must maintain the balance of Truth and Love

2) We must not dismiss Paul's teaching as "not pertaining to me"
