#### A. A Contrast In Leadership That Yields Opposite Results

1. Leadership motivated by **selfish** ambition (35-37)

- It does not count the cost of taking up the cross (38-40)
- It results in the separation of hearts one from another (41)
- It opens the door to all sorts of evil (Ja 3:14-16)
- 2. Leadership motivated by **service** to others (42-44)
  - It is in sharp contrast to the ways of the world (Ja 3:13,17-18)
  - It is one of God's measurements of true greatness (43,44)
  - It opens the door to blessing and uniting people together (45)
- QUESTION: In my leading, why do I lead? \_\_\_\_\_

#### B. A Team Ministry Leadership Model

- 1. Plurality of leadership with **equality** of authority
- 2. A specific move away from a *hierarchical* authority structure
- 3. Our process in moving toward this has been slow & deliberate

#### C. Biblical Support for A Team Leadership Model

- 1. We read of the **team** model throughout the New Testament
- 2. The early churches were led by a *plurality* of elders
- 3. There is a case to be made for **equal** authority among elders
  - We know of no hierarchical structure among the apostles
  - We do not read of a hierarchy existing among church elders

## D. Advantages of A Team Leadership Model

- 1. Promotes our belief that Jesus Christ is the **Chief** Shepherd
- 2. Elders must **prayerfully** work together to discern Christ's leading
- 3. Helps guard against the temptations & abuses that can come with an **exalted** leader
- 4. Guards against **dependency** on one man
- 5. Promotes **mutual** submission, relationship, and accountability
- 6. Gives great opportunity to model for the Body true **humility** that 'gives preference to one another in honor' (Ro 12:10/Phil 2:3/I Pt 5:3)
- 7. Honors the biblical principle of **wisdom** in multiple counselors
