"Hope That Perseveres & Brings Peace"

New Hope Community Church Romans 8:20-25 / Luke 2:25-32 December 5th, 2021

1. We have the hope of salvation, but not the sight of it (Ro 8:24)

- This hope is not the **wishful** thinking hope that the world has
- This hope is based on the **promise** of God • Romans 10:13 • John 1:12 • John 3:16
- God's promise is as trustworthy as His **character**

2. Unseen hope was demonstrated in the Christmas story (Lk 2)

- Simeon was longing for **comfort** for his people (2:25)
- God had promised him he would see **Messiah**! (2:26) (vs 27-32)
- Simeon's comfort (v 30) did not come from what he saw, but from what God had said

3. The hope of our salvation is not wishful thinking, but earnest expectation (Ro 8:25)

- In the midst of sorrow & pain, we live in the **confidence** of hope
- Because God has said it is so, we **patiently** wait
- Like Simeon, if we hope in God's promise, we have **peace**

True peace comes from staying anchored in the hope of Jesus' Second Coming, and with perseverance, watching for it with a daily eagerness!
