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- 1. At the Cross **Hopelessness** 
  - Why death brings an ache to our soul like nothing else —
  - Separation —the living spirit departs from the body
  - Hollowness no laughter, warmth, movement, conversation
  - Helplessness impossible to reverse
  - Finality the end of relationships
  - Sorrow all of the above leads to soul wrenching grief
  - Hopelessness any dreams, desires, wishes they are over!
- 2. At the Tomb Struggle
  - Mary's response unbelief (Jn 20:2)
  - John's response visual belief (20:8)
    - "perceive" = a seeing that becomes **knowing** (20:9)
  - The disciples' response stubborn unbelief (Mk 16:11)
- 3. First Appearance **Joyful** unbelief (Lk 24:36-45)
  - They doubted what their eyes were seeing (Lk 24:36,37)
  - They had inner turmoil (trouble) due to their doubt 38
  - Their great joy was a hindrance to an unshakeable faith (41)
  - Jesus helped them to understand the Scriptures (24:45)
- 4. Heavenly Appearance Full Surrender (Rv 1:12-18)
  - Jesus' appearance was overpowering (12-17a)
  - Jesus' words were absolute and authoritative (17b,18)
    - I am God (first & last) (Is 44:6)
    - I have conquered death
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
