#### A. The Marvel of the Incarnation (9-13)

- 1. The Creator took a position \_\_\_\_\_ the created (9)
  - Angels are \_\_\_\_\_ in power and responsibility (9a)
  - Jesus, in becoming man, \_\_\_\_\_ Himself to death (9b)

▶ <u>QUESTION</u>: In what way was Jesus crowned with glory and honor?

- First and foremost, He perfectly accomplished the Father's will
- He displayed an infinite measure of grace and love
- He displayed an infinite measure of holiness and justice
- $\bullet$  It was because of all this that God was able to exalt Him  $(\mbox{Phil}\ 2:9)$
- 2. The Father's will required the Son to \_\_\_\_\_ (10)

## B. The Necessity of the Incarnation (14-18)
