## A. Understanding the Prayer (12)

1. The word picture Jesus uses is very \_\_\_\_\_
  - **Literal interpretation: debt, something that is** \_\_\_\_\_
  - **Metaphorical use: a sin or an** \_\_\_\_\_
2. One biblical depiction of our sin - hopeless \_\_\_\_\_
  - **Our debt was \_\_\_\_\_ to the cross** Col 2:13,14
  - **As we continue to sin, our forgiven debt** \_\_\_\_\_
3. As people sin against us, we can feel a debt is \_\_\_\_\_
  - **Just as we ask release from our debts owed to God, so we are to \_\_\_\_\_ others from what they owe to us**

## B. Sobering Commentary On the Prayer (14,15)

1. Receiving God’s forgiveness is tied to us \_\_\_\_\_ it
2. God’s forgiveness has a \_\_\_\_\_ component to it
  - **Our past: In \_\_\_\_\_, we have been forgiven**
  - **Our present: In \_\_\_\_\_, we are being forgiven**
  - **Our future: In glorification, forgiveness \_\_\_\_\_ realized**
3. Consequences from God \_\_\_\_\_ forgiveness
  - **Intimate \_\_\_\_\_ is sacrificed** (Ps 66:18)
  - **Spiritual \_\_\_\_\_ is hindered** (Ja 4:6)
  - **Unforgiveness moves toward \_\_\_\_\_** (Hb 12:14,15)

## C. Forgiveness Through Living the Gospel

1. There is One Who has all ability to forgive: \_\_\_\_\_
  - **On the \_\_\_\_\_ He prayed: Father, forgive them**
  - **While \_\_\_\_\_ He reconciled us thru His death**
2. This One offers us the \_\_\_\_\_ ability thru His Spirit
  - **He commands us to forgive \_\_\_\_\_ He does** (Eph 4:30-32)
  - **‘I can do \_\_\_\_\_ things thru Christ Who strengthens me’**

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2. One biblical depiction of our sin - hopeless **debtors**
  - **Our debt was nailed to the cross** Col 2:13,14
  - **As we continue to sin, our forgiven debt increases**
3. As people sin against us, we can feel a debt is **owed**
  - **Just as we ask release from our debts owed to God, so we are to release others from what they owe to us**

## B. Sobering Commentary On the Prayer (14,15)

1. Receiving God’s forgiveness is tied to us **granting** it
2. God’s forgiveness has a **threefold** component to it
  - **Our past: In Christ, we have been forgiven**
  - **Our present: In confession, we are being forgiven**
  - **Our future: In glorification, forgiveness fully realized**
3. Consequences from God **withholding** forgiveness
  - **Intimate relationship is sacrificed** (Ps 66:18)
  - **Spiritual growth is hindered** (Ja 4:6)
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## C. Forgiveness Through Living the Gospel

1. There is One Who has all ability to forgive: **Jesus**
  - **On the cross He prayed: Father, forgive them**
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
