B. Sobering Commentary On the Prayer (14,15)

- 1. Receiving God's forgiveness is tied to us **granting** it
- 2. God's forgiveness has a **threefold** component to it
 - Our past: In Christ, we have been forgiven
 - Our present: In confession, we are being forgiven
 - Our future: In glorification, forgiveness fully realized
- 3. Consequences from God withholding forgiveness
 - Intimate relationship is sacrificed (Ps 66:18)
 - **Spiritual growth is hindered** (Ja 4:6)
 - Unforgiveness moves toward bitterness (Hb 12:14,15)
