<b>gentleness</b> (meekness)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• "surrendered to the master"</li><li>• giving up my self-centered sense of rights / privileges</li></ul>
<b>patience</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• cutting you some slack</li><li>• reduce agitated emotions during stressful moments</li></ul>
<b>bearing with one another in love</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• enduring uncomfortable situations</li><li>• forgiving when others sin (against you)</li></ul>

<b>Apostle</b>	extends; expands; pioneers; entrepreneurial missionary who is “sent” into new territory	un-surrendered ground held by satan and the world	35 times the Bible says Jesus was “sent” by the Father (Jn 3:16; 17:18)
<b>Prophet</b>	confronts; corrects; reminds the Church of God’s will and its moral compass	any injustices; anything that is wrong	Jesus was a prophet who called the world to faith and righteousness (Lk 24:19)
<b>Evangelist</b>	reaches out to the lost; expands the team following Jesus	a world of unbelief	Jesus came to seek and save the lost (Lk 19:10; 1 Tim 1:15)
<b>Shepherd (Pastor)</b>	nurtures the community; relates, helps, forgives, heals and protects	brokenness and hurt found among people	Jesus was the good shepherd who gave his life for others (Jn 10:11-15)
<b>Teacher</b>	instructs; explains; organizes the Body of Christ	ignorance or falsehood	Jesus taught with unique power and authority (Mt 7:28-29)
